MEMBER'S CODE OF ETHICS

The members of the National Entlebucher Mountain Dog Association share a deep concern for the welfare and future of the Entlebucher Mountain Dog (EMD). This Code is established in accordance with the objectives set out in the club Constitution as the minimum standards of practice for the responsible and ethical ownership of the Entlebucher Mountain Dog. Violations of NEMDA's Code of Ethics will be subject to NEMDA Disciplinary procedures, and may be grounds for expulsion.

When a Member cannot keep their Entlebucher and does not have a suitable new home available, NEMDA strongly recommends and prefers that the Member first contact their Breeder for re-homing assistance. If failing at that, the Member should contact NEMDA for re-homing/rescue assistance. Members shall resolve to abide by the Constitution, Bylaws and standards of AKC and NEMDA (as noted on NEMDA's website www.nemda.org) and to always conduct themselves in a manner that will be beneficial to the club, the breed and its reputation. Members shall cooperate with all health surveys or other record requirements set up to research and promote the health of the breed, and report major health problems to their breeder and the Genetics Committee. Members shall not defame other club members, breeders, exhibitors or their dogs.
