What You Can Do With This Database

The information is to be used by owners, owners-to-be, breeders, researchers, veterinarians, or anyone who is interested in seeing photos or family relationships, locating their next matchmaking mate, or in the inheritance of traits or diseases in the Entlebucher breed.

You do not need an account to view the profiles and pedigrees of dogs in the database, find breeders and stud dogs, calculate the coefficient of inbreeding (COI) for trial matings, or just browse the Entlebucher pedigrees.

If you **sign up for a free account**, you will have more powerful search options and be able to edit dogs, submit new dogs, upload photos, and more. Below, you'll find instructions on how to get started. Please be aware that most additions and changes to data are verified and approved by a volunteer on the Pedigree Database Committee and may take a few days to appear online. *The more accurate and careful you are with the edits and additions you submit, the more quickly we'll be able to verify your requests. So please double-check your typing before submitting your requests.*

GETTING STARTED

1. **Create an account in the database** by going to EntlebucherDatabase.nemda.org. Once there, click on the **Sign up for free** link in the bottom right corner of the gray log-in box.

You will have the choice of either a **basic** or an **owner-breeder** account. The differences are explained in the application form and you can switch account types later if needed. After completing the application, you will soon receive an email with a link and details for logging in.

2. **Verify the accuracy of the information for your dogs.** Use any of the search functions to find your dogs. Check to see that the basic information is correct. The most important fields for this are:
 - a. Registered Name
 - b. Country of Birth
 - c. Date of Birth

- d. AKC or Foreign Registration number
- e. Date of Death if deceased
- f. Sire and Dam (see pedigree)

Note: If you need to modify these or any other fields, click on  after your dog's name and select **edit** from the drop-down menu. A form will pop up allowing you to fill in missing information or correct existing data. In the process of making the improvements to the database, some information may not be exactly where it should be. Please edit your dogs so everything is where it should be.

4. **Add more details to your dog(s) records such as physical traits, health evaluations, or a title or award.**

To add CEBA Conformation and CEBA Temperament, starting with the most recent year, enter the years of the evaluations separated by a space. You can find the years of your dog's evaluations on NEMDA's website at <https://nemda.org/CEBA-Teams> (you will be prompted to log in if necessary).

- 5. Upload photos of your dogs. Photos really bring the database to life. Currently you can upload three (3) for each dog.
- 6. **If you are a breeder, you can register a litter.** At the top of the home page you will see a link to **litter registrations**. If you are the breeder of a litter, you can register a new litter.

- 8. **Example Dogs.** There are currently almost 20,000 dogs in the database. Most of these come from a snapshot we have of the previous database which was saved in 2020 and more than 90% of them are internationally bred. You are encouraged to look at the dogs owned by the members of the Pedigree Database (PDB) committee to see the many types of information that can be stored in the database. You can find any of these dogs by using the **Entlebuchers**



search area  at the very top and center of every page in the database (start typing the dog's name and then select the dog from the drop-down menu).
